INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the **CLB Baseball Replay Application**—your personal baseball time machine.

If you've ever wondered *"What if history played out differently?"*, this application gives you the chance to find out. Every season from 1964 through 1983 has been replayed in full, allowing you to compare simulated results against real Major League Baseball history.

This project was inspired by a lifelong love of the game. My journey began at my first Baltimore Orioles game in 1966. The Orioles lost that day—but it didn't matter. From that moment on, baseball became more than just a sport—it became a passion.

The period from 1964 to 1983 represents what I consider the **golden era of baseball**:

- Players stayed with teams longer
- The game emphasized fundamentals and strategy
- Statistics told the story of performance
- And yes—the Orioles were one of the dominant teams of the era

We already know what actually happened during these seasons. But this application asks a different question:

 *What would happen if we played it all again?*

Using **APBA Baseball for Windows (Version 5.5)**, every regular season game was replayed:

- **38,384 regular season games**
- **160 League Championship Series games**
- **114 World Series games**

All results—both replay and actual—are stored and analyzed using Microsoft Access databases, including historical data from the Lahman Baseball Database.

This application brings together:

- Player data
- Team performance
- Historical records
- Advanced statistics
- And interactive tools

New to the replay? Let's get you into the game right away.

This quick start guide will walk you through the most common things users want to do—no technical experience required.

Step 1: Start at Home Plate

When the application opens, you'll land on the **HOME window**—your dugout and command center.

From here, you can:

- Select teams
- Search for players
- Explore seasons
- Dive into analytics

 Think of this as your lineup card—it all starts here.

Step 2: Find a Player

Want to look up a favorite player?

1. Click **Players** from the top menu
2. Enter a full or partial name
3. Press **Search**
4. Double-click a player's name

You'll open the **Player Profile window**—your digital baseball card packed with:

- Biographical details
- Career statistics
- Baseball card images
- Replay vs. actual comparisons

In **Demographics** or **Stats Central**, simply type a question like:

- “List players born in 1955”
- “Right-handed pitchers on the 1969 Orioles”
- “Home runs by Reggie Jackson from 1969–1972”

Then:

1. Click **Get SQL Query**
2. Click **Run Query**

👉 The system translates your question and delivers the results instantly.

- Look up Frank Robinson and compare his career

Now that you've stepped into the replay, it's time to get comfortable in the ballpark.


This application is designed to feel like you're part of a complete baseball organization. Whether you want to act as a manager, scout, historian, or front office analyst, everything you need is just a few clicks away.

How the Application Is Organized

Think of the application as a baseball operation, with each section representing a different role:

- **Home** → Your dugout (starting point for everything)
- **Players** → Your scouting department
- **Teams** → Your clubhouse and organization view
- **Seasons** → League history and standings
- **Demographics** → Front office analytics
- **Stats Central** → Deep statistical analysis

Each area is connected, allowing you to move seamlessly from one part of the game to another.

 Example: Start with a team → open a roster → select a player → compare stats → return to league view.

Basic Navigation Tips

🚫 SECTION 4 - REPLAY VS. ACTUAL RESULTS - ASSUMPTIONS, DATA, AND METHODOLOGY

This application compares simulated (“replay”) baseball seasons with historical (“actual”) Major League Baseball results for the years 1964–1983. As you explore players, teams, and seasons, you may notice differences between Replay Results and Actual Results. These differences are expected—and are a direct result of how the replay seasons were constructed.

The following section explains the key assumptions, data sources, and statistical methods used throughout the application.

1. Schedule and Games Played

- **Replay Seasons:**

Each replay season follows a complete schedule of **162 games per team**, regardless of historical irregularities.

- **Actual Seasons:**

In real-life seasons, some teams played fewer than 162 games due to cancellations that were **not rescheduled**.

- **Labor Disruptions Impacting Actual Data:**

- **1972 Season:**

A labor dispute delayed the start of the season, resulting in **86 canceled games** that were never made up.

- **1981 Season:**

A mid-season players’ strike (June 12 – July 31) led to **713 canceled games**, also not made up.

- **Impact on Comparisons:**

Because replay seasons always contain 162 games while some actual seasons do not, **raw counting statistics (e.g., hits, runs, HR)** may not align directly. Rate statistics (e.g., averages, percentages) are generally more comparable.

2. Roster Construction

- **1964–1976 Seasons:**

- Each team uses a fixed **25-player roster**:

- 15 non-pitchers
 - 10 pitchers
 - **1977–1983 Seasons:**
 - Replay rosters are built to **match actual team roster sizes**.
 - There is **no fixed limit** on pitchers vs. position players.
 - Not all players on a roster are guaranteed to appear in replay games.
-

3. Statistical Calculations and Constraints

- **League-Based Metrics (e.g., OPS+, WAR):**
 - For **1964–1976**, league averages are calculated using only the **25 selected players per team**, not full historical rosters.
 - As a result, some derived statistics may **differ from official MLB values**.
 - **Implication:**
 - These statistics remain internally consistent within the replay environment but may not exactly match published historical figures.
-

4. Win Shares Methodology

- **Win Shares**, developed by Bill James, is used to evaluate player contributions.
- Key principles:
 - A team earns **3 Win Shares per victory**.
 - Example: 90 team wins = 270 total Win Shares distributed to players.
 - Win Shares allocate credit across:
 - Offensive performance
 - Defensive contributions
 - Pitching effectiveness
- **Purpose:**

This system measures how much a player contributed to **actual team wins**, rather than focusing solely on individual statistics.





5. Replay vs. Actual Data Interpretation

When comparing replay results to actual historical outcomes, users should consider:

- Differences in **games played** (especially 1972 and 1981)
- Variations in **roster size and usage**
- Adjustments in **league-average-based statistics**
- The controlled nature of replay simulations vs. real-world variability

6. Additional Considerations

To better understand the results, the following factors should also be kept in mind:

- **Player Usage Patterns:**
Replay simulations may distribute playing time differently than real-life managerial decisions.
- **Injury and Transaction Effects:**
Real-world roster changes (injuries, trades, call-ups) may not be fully replicated in the replay environment.
- **Statistical Normalization:**
Some discrepancies are expected due to:
 - Controlled roster sizes (1964–1976)
 - Differences in league context calculations

Summary

This system is designed to provide a **controlled, consistent simulation environment** while preserving the core structure of historical baseball seasons. Differences between replay and actual results are expected and reflect both:

- Real-world irregularities (e.g., strikes, cancellations)
- Necessary modeling assumptions for simulation consistency

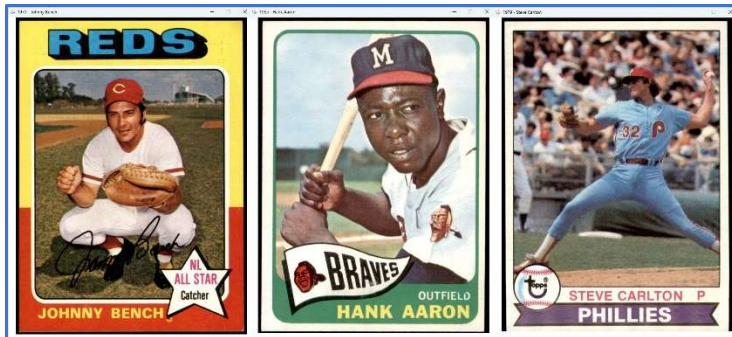

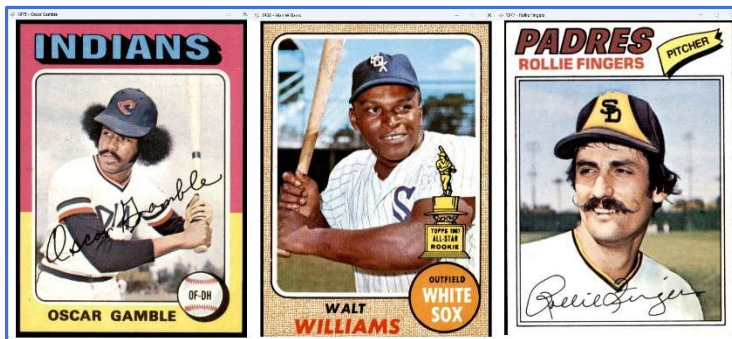

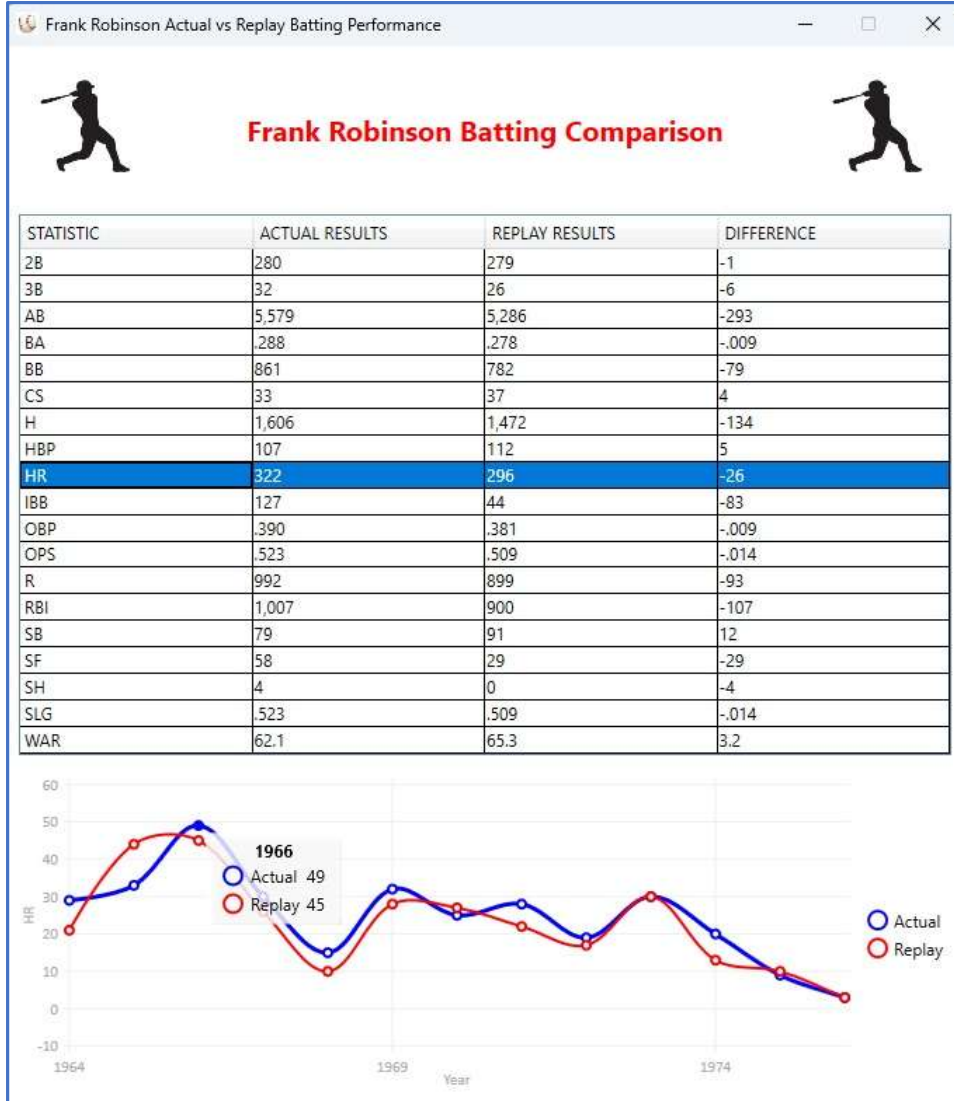

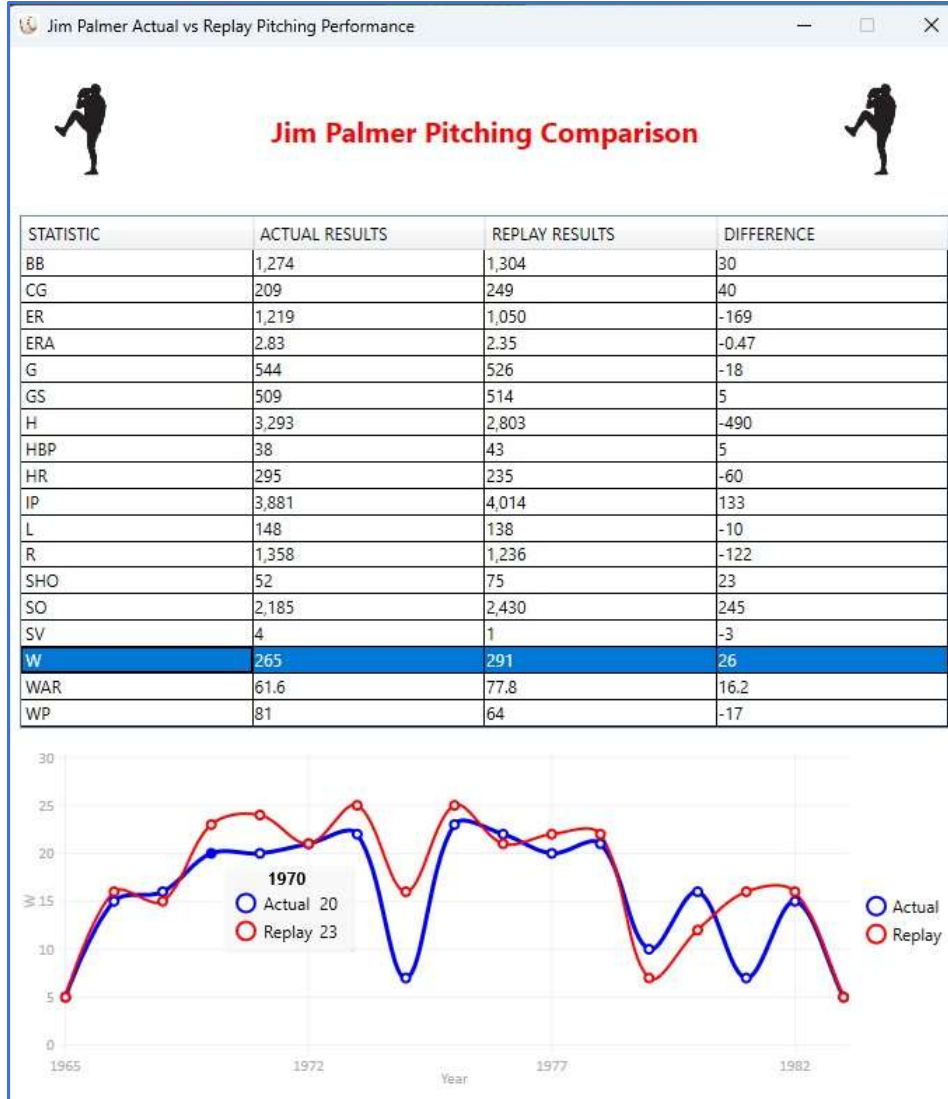

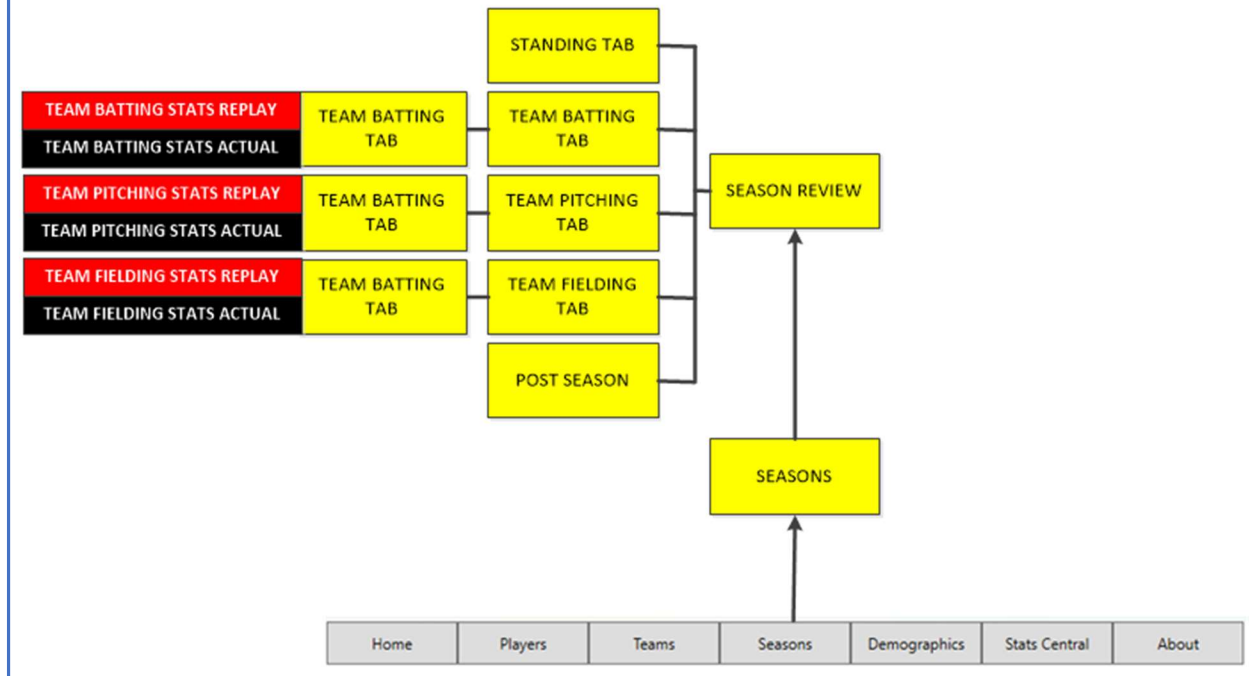
